

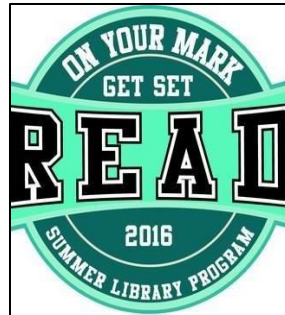

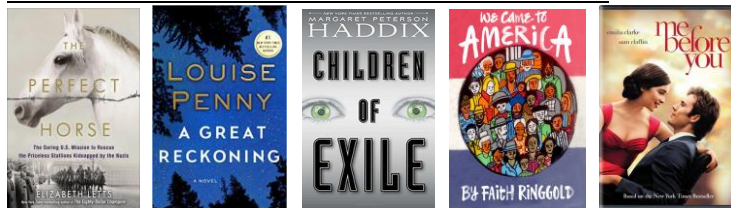
The Mexico Public Library Annual 5K Cider Run & Walk, along with a half mile kids Fun Run was held on Saturday, September 17th
